MEMORANDUM FOR ALL AREA V PERSONNEL

FROM: 51 FW/CC

SUBJECT: Off-Limit Establishments and Guest Escort Policy

1. The procedures discussed below are in effect immediately and will remain in effect until rescinded.
2. This policy letter is established in accordance with USFK Regulation 190-2 and USFK Regulation 190-7. This policy applies to the following:
  - a. Active duty U.S. Armed Forces personnel who are assigned to the United States Forces, Korea, or who are within the ROK while on leave or temporary duty.
  - b. Reserve personnel who are performing annual or other training in the ROK.
  - c. National Guard personnel who are performing training in a Federal status in the ROK.
  - d. All U.S. citizen civilian employees of the Department of Defense (DOD) and non appropriated fund instrumentalities supporting USFK, DOD Invited Contractors, and Technical Representatives.
  - e. The dependents/family members of all personnel listed in paragraphs 2a through 2d, above.
3. Off-Limits Areas Policy: 51 FW/CC is designated the Area V Commander per USFK regulation 10-2 and 190-50. Area V consists of Osan AB, plus the Collocated Operating Bases (COB), specifically Suwon AB, Cheong JU AB, Gwang Ju AB, Daegue AB, and Gimhe AB. This includes a 3 kilometer radius around each base. 51 FW/CC had been delegated authority over all military personnel and property to include law enforcement responsibility within these areas. The following areas and establishments within Area V are off-limits to all personnel in paragraph 2 except as noted below.
  - a. All tattoo parlors and body piercing shops. This paragraph does not apply to personnel listed in paragraph 2 (d) and (e).
  - b. All houses of prostitution. A house of prostitution is defined as any building or structure where prostitution or the promotion of prostitution (engaging in any sexual activity with another person for a fee) is regularly carried on by one or more persons under the control, management, or supervision of another.
  - c. The ROK public streets, roads, and highways during the hours of curfew when established by the ROK Government. Travel during curfew hours is permitted, in emergencies or when performing official duties.
  - d. Any other establishment/area as ordered by the Area V Commander.
  - e. Off-limits areas during emergencies may be established by the 51 FW/CC, Defense Force Commander (DFC) or the Noncommissioned Officer in Charge (NCOIC), 51 SFS/Town Patrol, when there is insufficient time to carryout normal procedures and unsatisfactory conditions warrant immediate

action. Emergency sanctions imposed by the NCOIC, Town Patrol will not exceed 12 hours in durations unless ratified in writing by the 51 FW/CC. The DFC will be immediately notified of any off-limits sanctions imposed by the NCOIC, Town Patrol.

f. The Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board will make recommendations to the Area Commander as needed and to declare additional areas off-limits to preserve good order and discipline, health, morale, safety, and welfare of personnel. As areas are deemed off-limits notification will be made through the Chain of Command.

4. Osan AB Guest Escort Policy: Guests may be escorted onto the installation by US military personnel, US military dependents (18 and older), US citizens entitled to use base facilities and other personnel authorized by the 51MSG/CC. Non-Korean personnel, including US citizens, must present a valid passport, ROK alien registration card and must exchange another form of valid photo ID such as a driver's license. Korean national guests, age 18 and over, will present either their Korean passport or official ID card, with photo (not drivers license). Korean nationals between the ages of 13 and 17 will present their school identification card. Escort and guest must appear together at the Main (pedestrian) Gate or Doolittle Gate when requesting, returning or reregistering passes. Sponsors are responsible for visitors and must stay with them at all times. Failure to return a pass by the required time could result in escort privileges being revoked.

a. Day Pass: Day passes are available between the following times: Sun-Thurs 0500-2400, Fri-Sat 0500-0300. Visitors must either be reregistered by an authorized escort or deregistered by their escort and exit the installation. Visitors are not allowed to reside in dormitories, they may stay in lodging or on-base housing.


b. 72 Hour Pass: Temporary visitors must be registered and escorted with passes issued up to a maximum of 72 hours. Guests on 72 hour passes are PROHIBITED from staying in unaccompanied housing (dormitories).

c. Short Term Visitors: Personnel visiting assigned USFK DOD personnel may receive a pass valid for up to 30 days. Short term visitor passes must be processed through 51 SFS Pass and Registration to the 51 MSG/CC for approval. Request must be completed prior to their arrival.

5. This policy will be strictly enforced. All US Armed Forces personnel who fail to comply with this policy are in violation of Article 92, UCMJ and will be subject to judicial and/or adverse administrative action.

6. All commanders will ensure their military members understand this policy.
