Mr. Craig L. Deatrick assumed duties as the Director, Forces, Resources and Assessments, J8, US Forces, Korea on 15 May 2018.

His educational background includes a Bachelor of Arts Degree in History from the University of California, Irvine, and a Master of Science Degree in National Resource Strategy from the National Defense University, where he graduated as a Distinguished Graduate. He is also a graduate of Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government, Senior Fellows program. His military education includes graduation from the Army Management Staff College in FT Belvoir, VA, and the Combined Arms and Services Staff School in FT Leavenworth, KS.

Mr. Deatrick's service began nearly 35 years ago when he joined the U.S. Army; he's served the DoD continuously in some capacity ever since. Throughout his career Mr. Deatrick served in a series of positions with ever-increasing responsibilities including the Director of Logistics (DOL) for an Area Support Group in Europe and later DOL at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii. He's served as Regional Chief of Logistics for the Army's Installation Management Command in both Europe and Pacific Regions. Prior to joining the USFK team, Mr. Deatrick served as the Chief of Staff for the Army's Installation Management Command's Pacific Region leading over 120 staff members across 11 Garrisons with over 10,000 employees and a budget of \$1.1B. During his most recent assignment, Mr. Deatrick served as the Deputy J4 for USFK overseeing the J4 staff with the responsibility of providing policy and management for logistics across the Korean Peninsula for more than 28,000 US Forces stationed in Korea during armistice, crisis, and contingencies.
