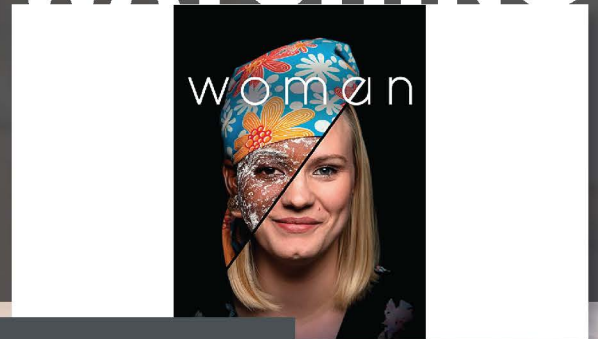
WHAT ARE WE...
